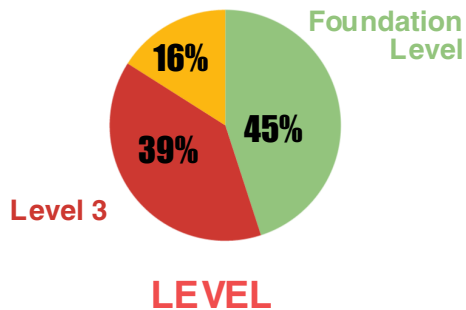

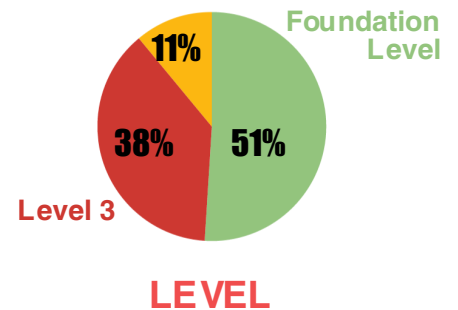

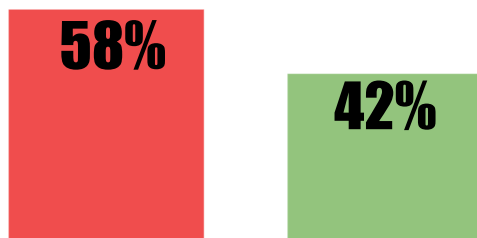

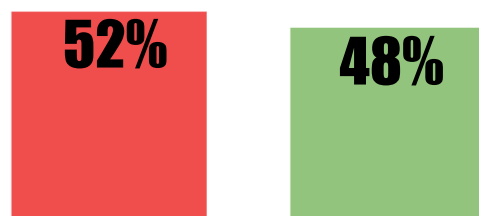

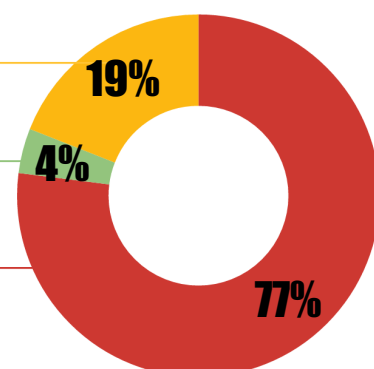
## 03 EMPLOYMENT

**Economically inactive**

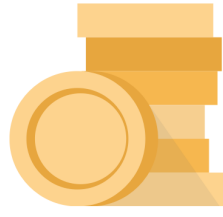


Employment for those with Level 3 qualifications is 71%
