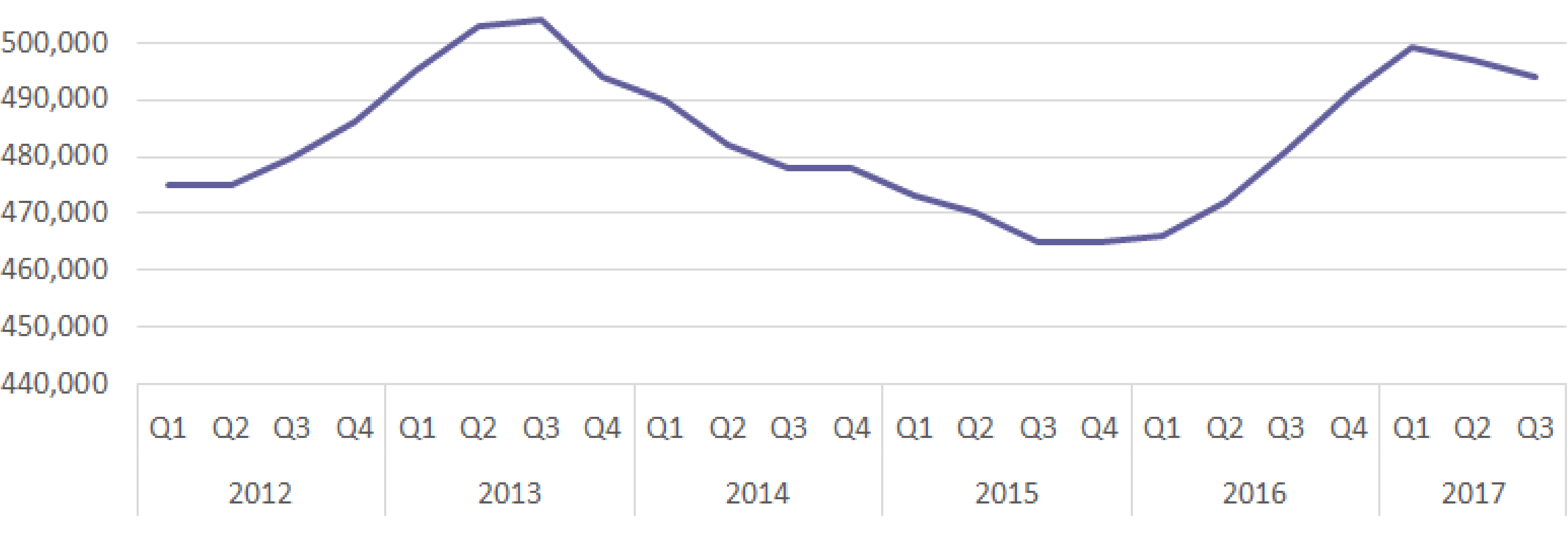

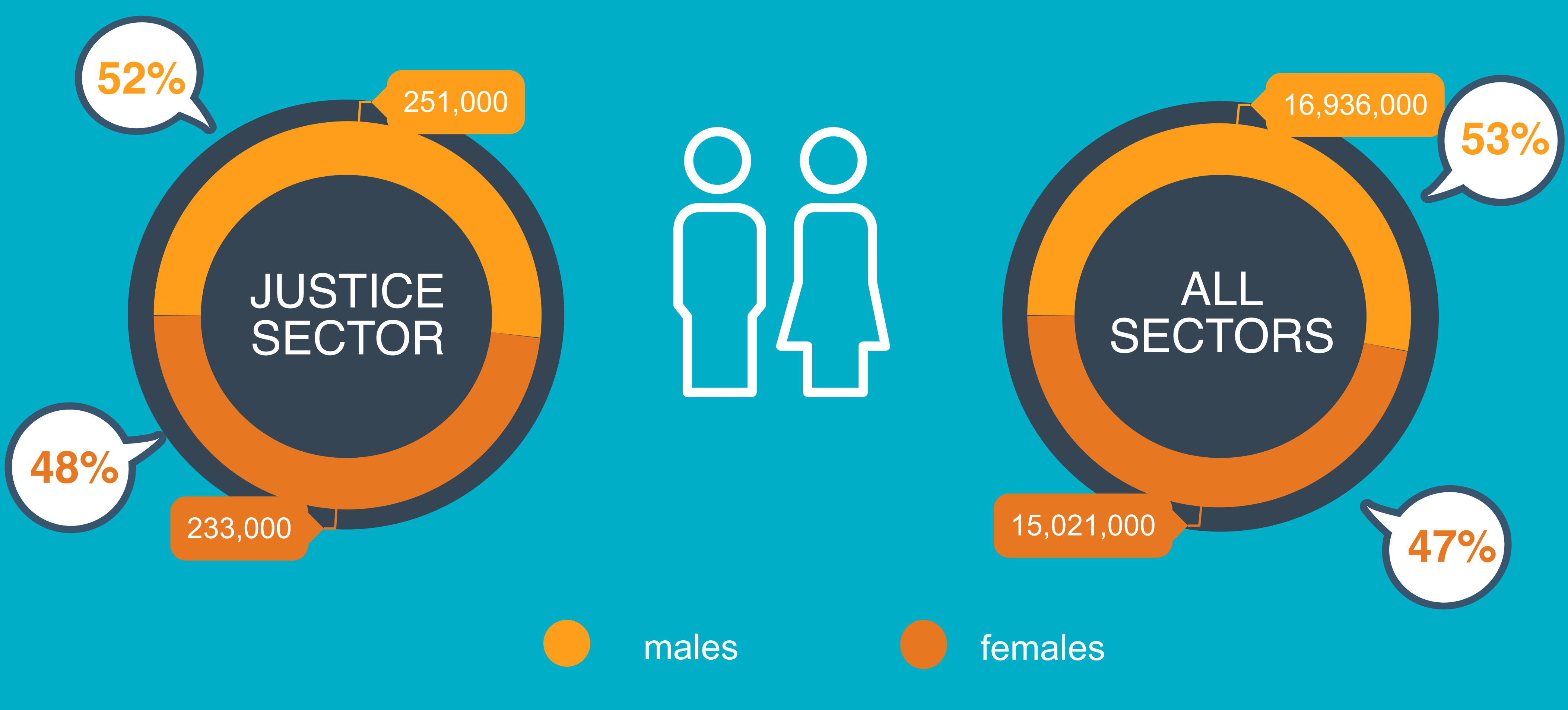

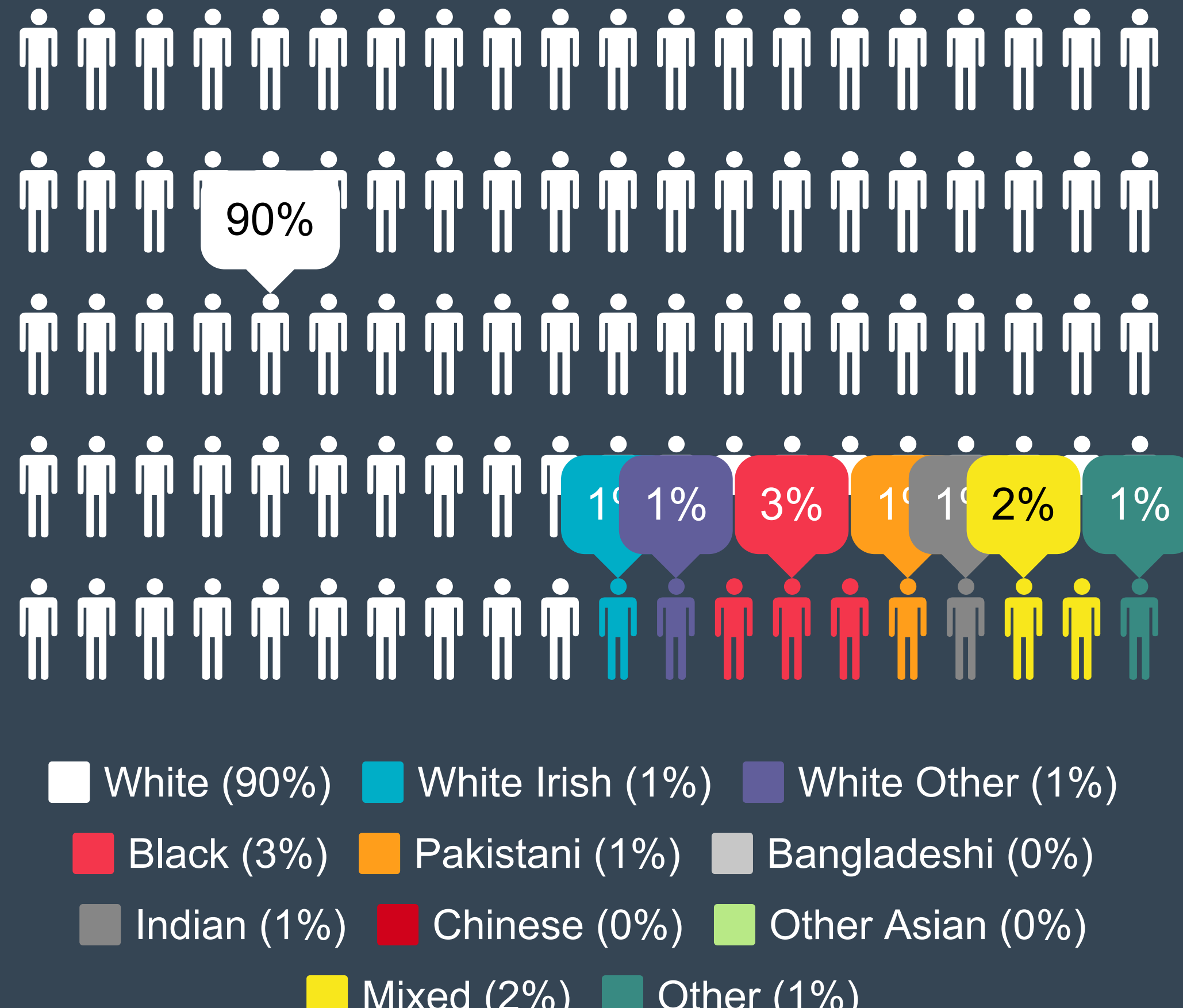
02 REGIONAL EMPLOYMENT



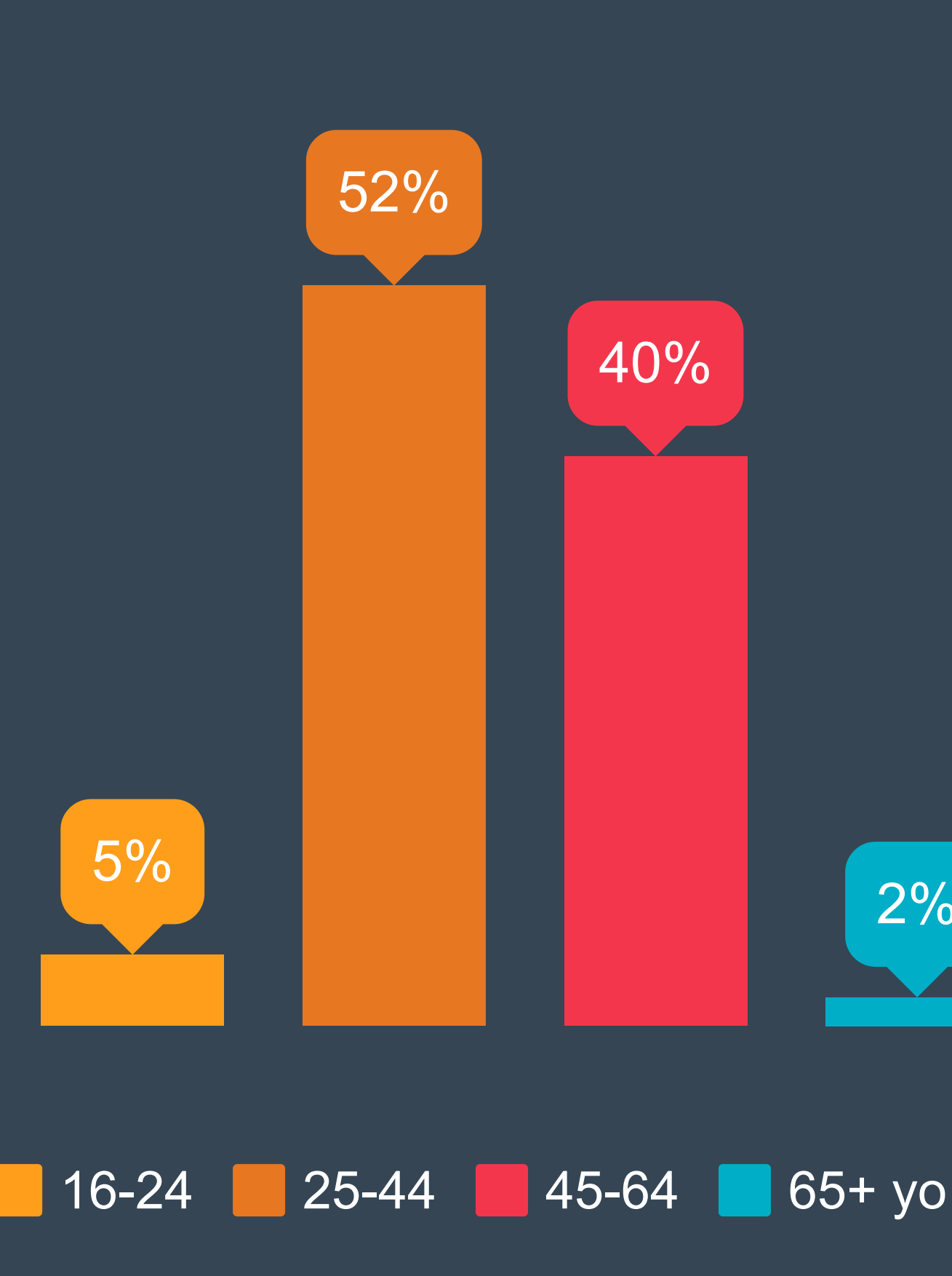
03 GENDER



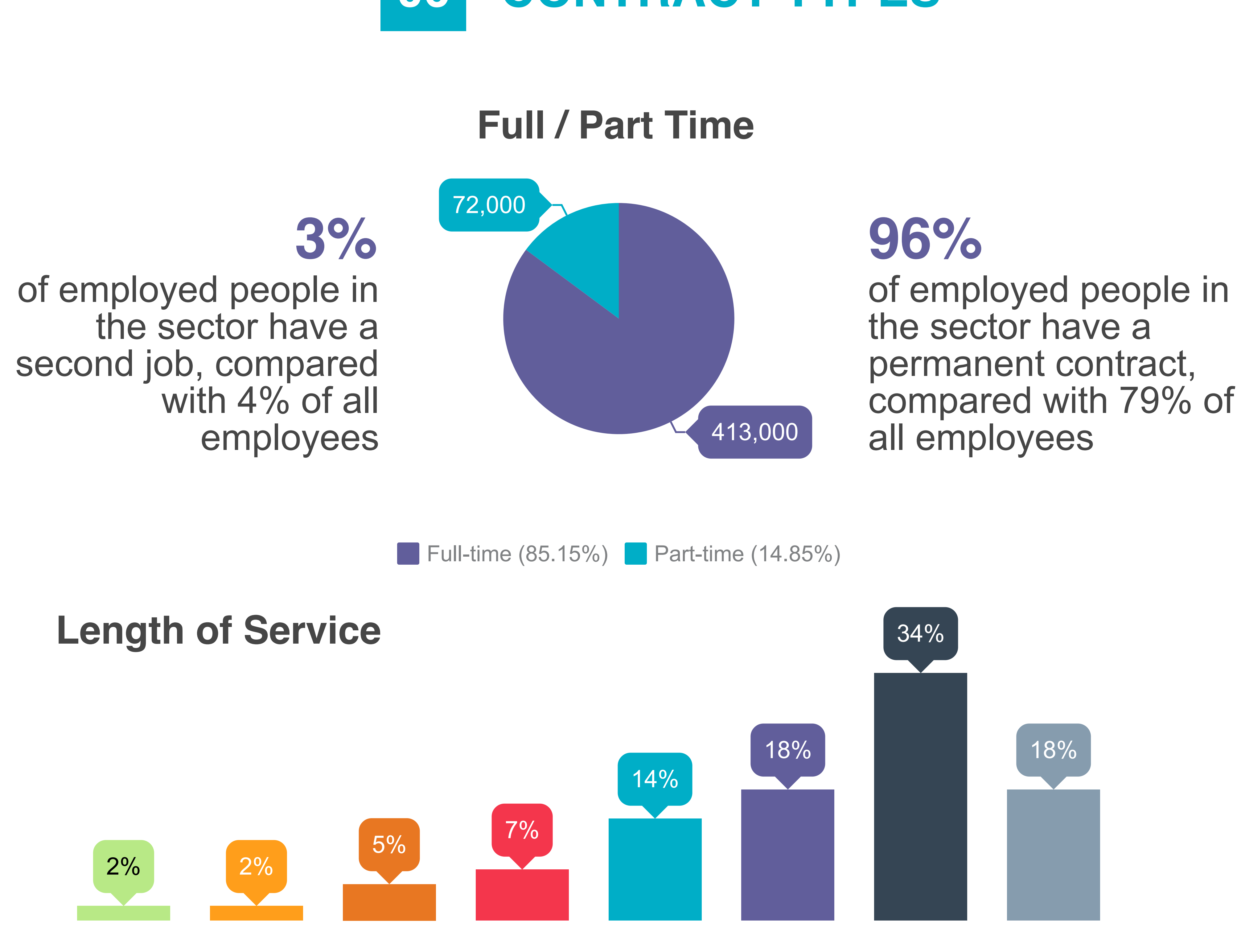

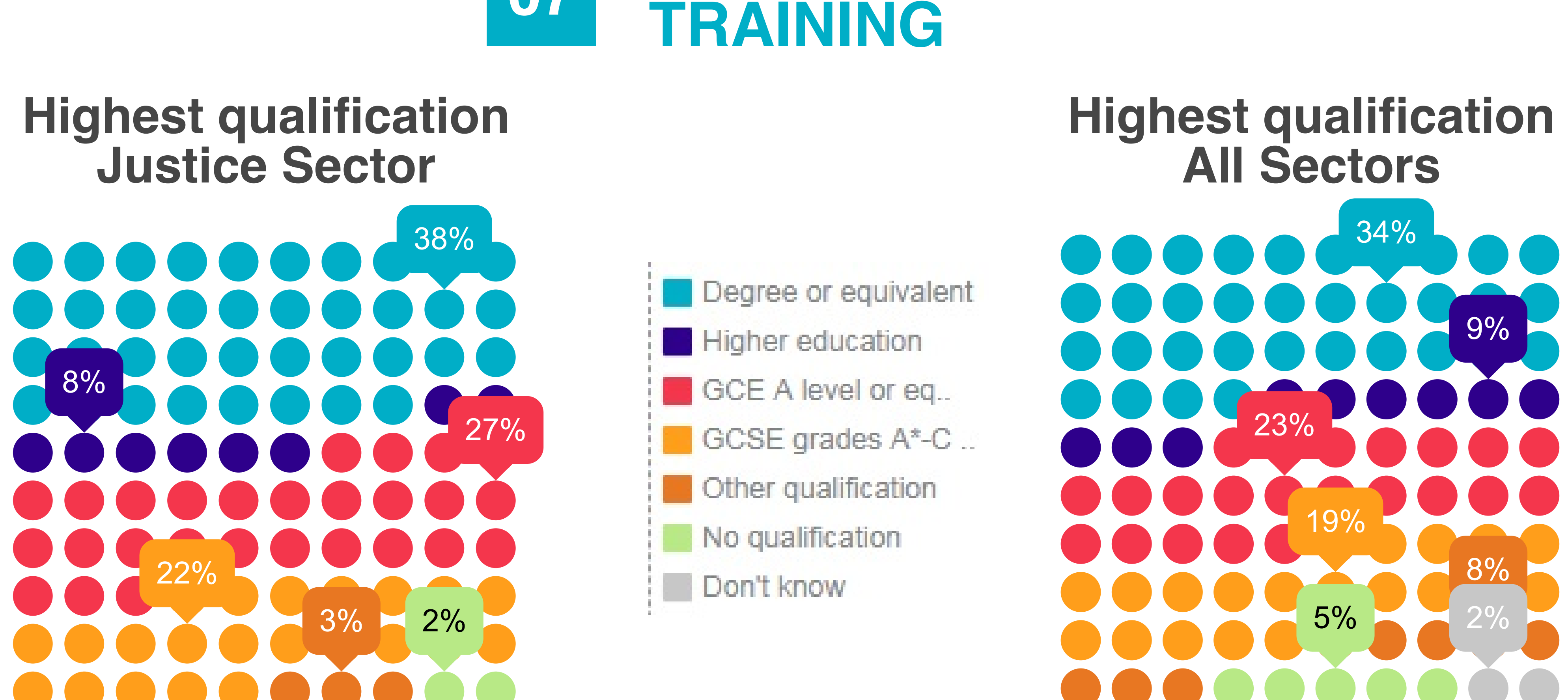

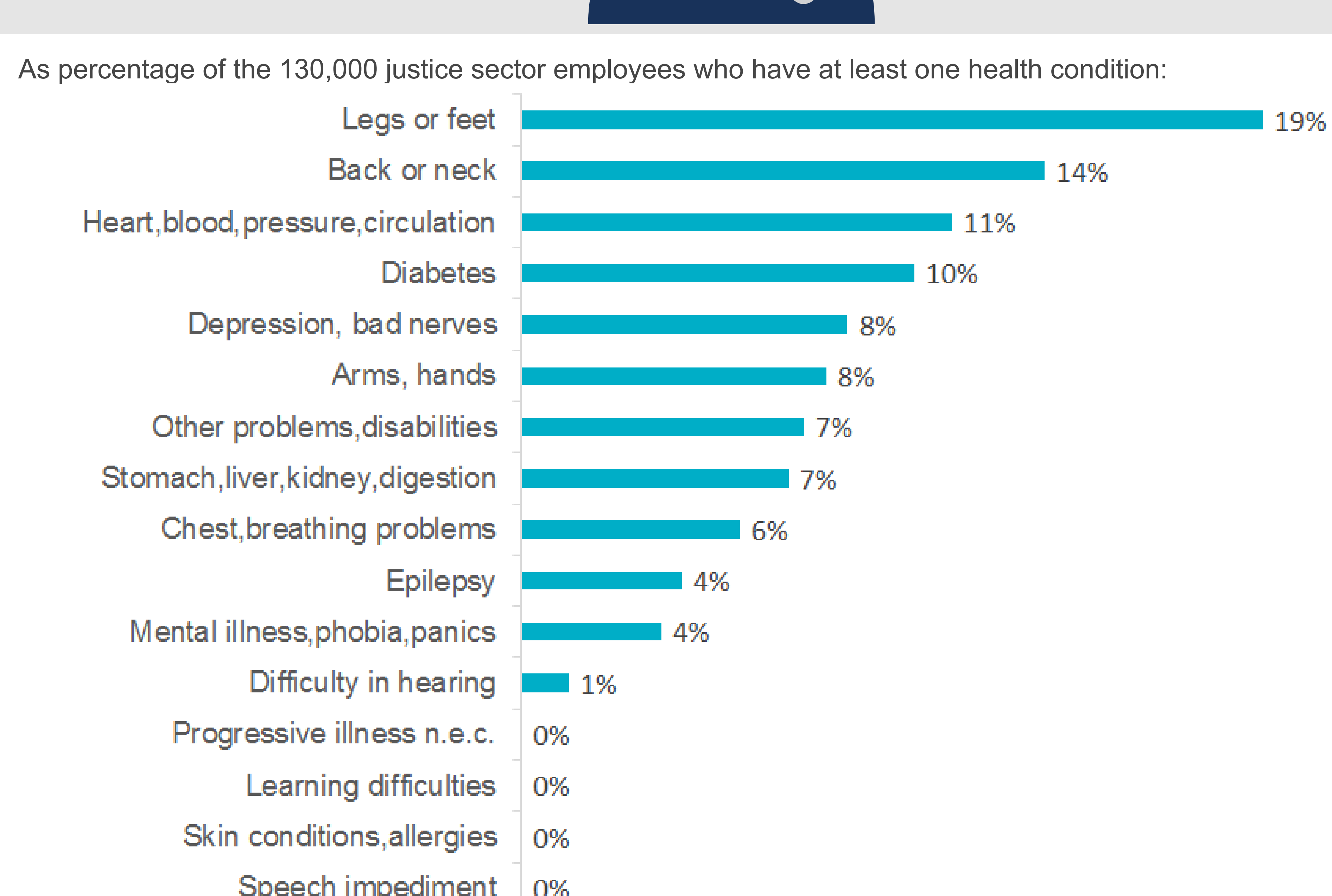
