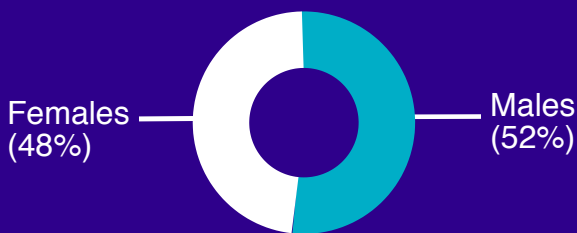

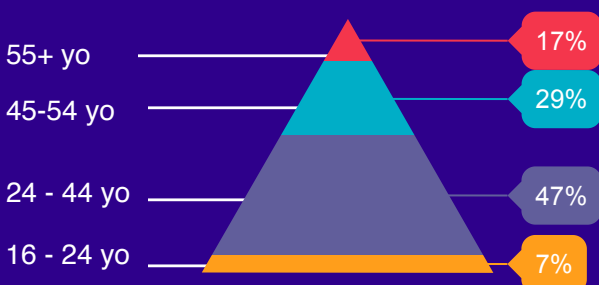

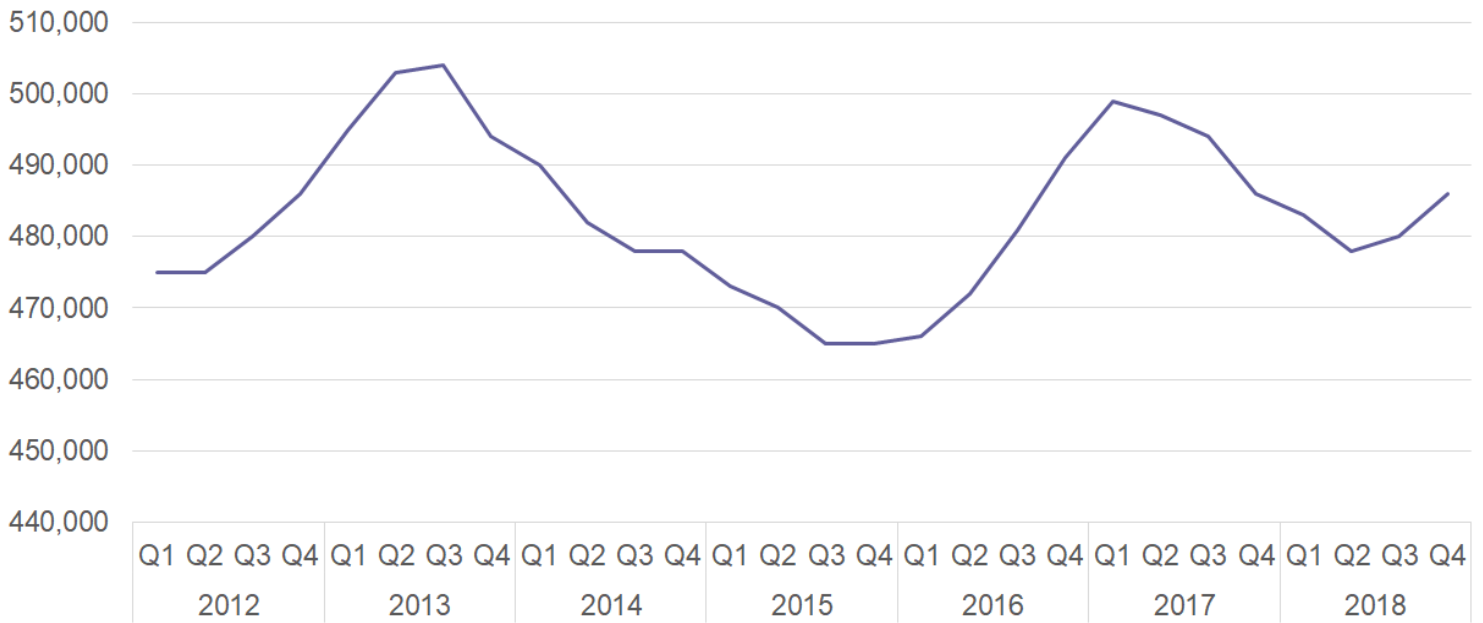

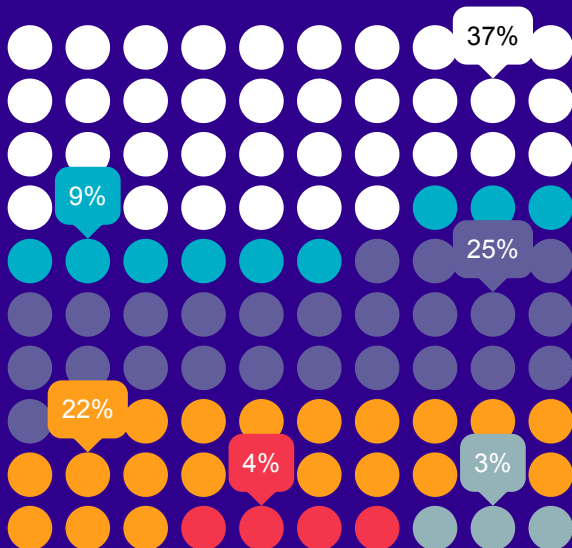

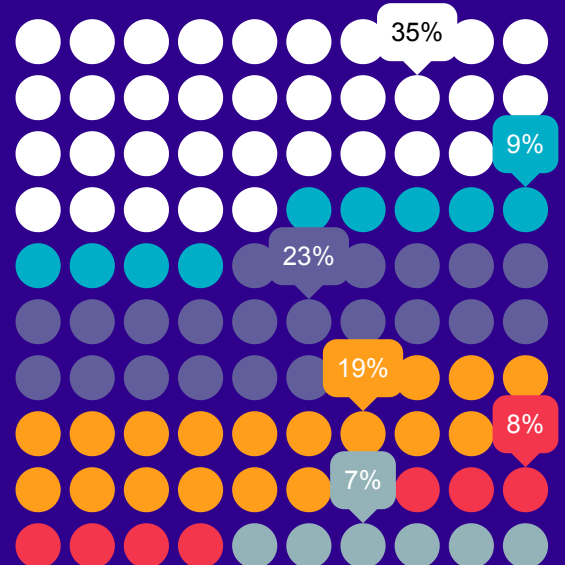

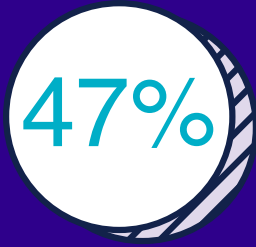

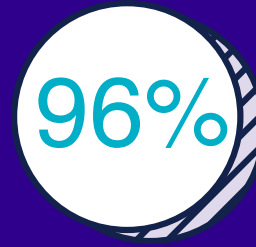

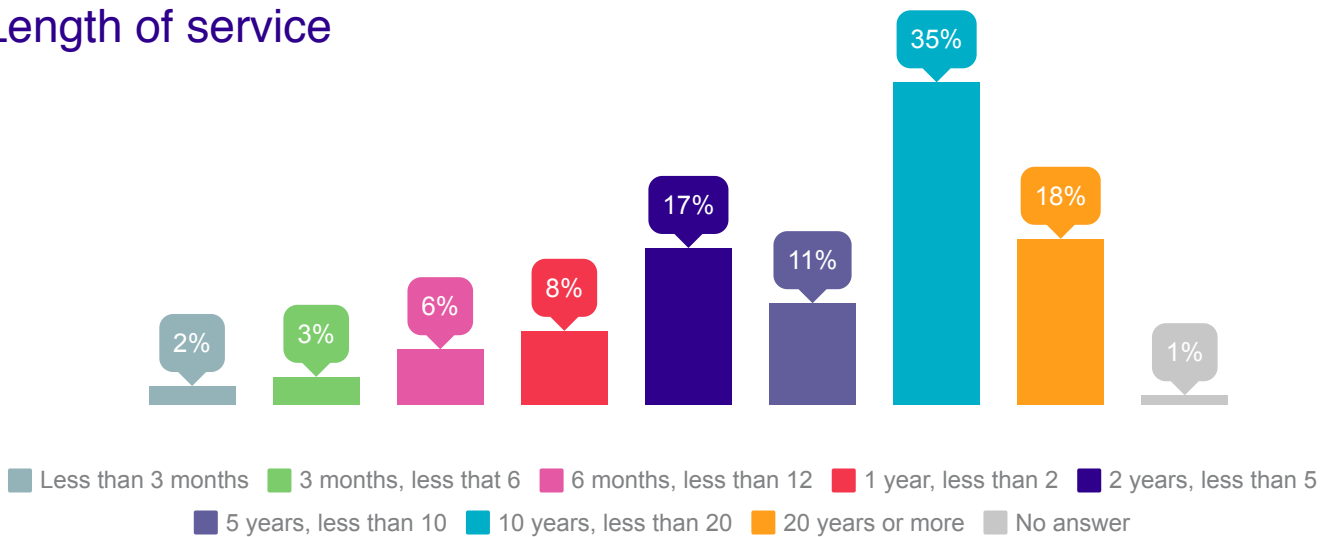


of employees in policing & law enforcement have worked **overtime (paid or unpaid)**, compared with 33% of all employees
